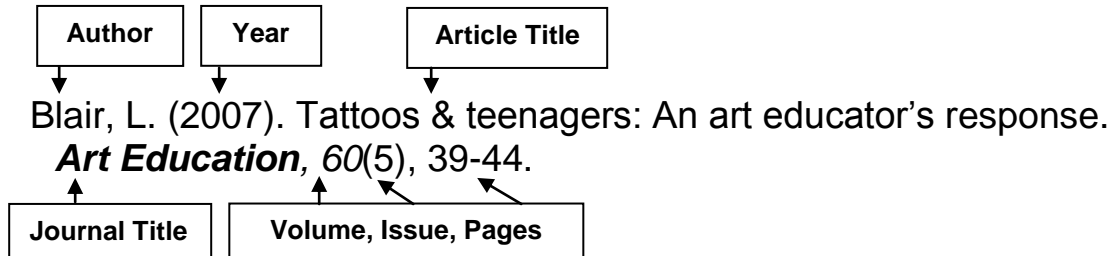


Finding Full Text

Sometimes you will be able to read or print an entire article from a database. Other times you will only have a **citation**, and perhaps an **abstract** that summarizes the article. Using the **citation**, you can find the article in a few simple steps.

1) The citation provides all of the information you need to find an article.

2) There are two ways to determine if an article is available through the Library.

A) From within databases, use the **Get it @ UP** link. This link will display for each result when full text is not immediately available in that particular database.

An automatic search of the **Get it @ UP** tool will be run for the journal or magazine where the article appears.

B) When you have a citation that someone gave you or one from a bibliography, go to the library homepage, and choose the **Journal Titles A-Z** link.

TIP: Search using the title of the journal or magazine. Do not use the article title.

Get it @ UP and **Journal Titles A-Z** will indicate if the publication is available in the library or if the full text for that publication is available online in one of the library's databases.

① When the **Resource** is a database name it means the full text is available online. Make sure your article falls within the date range and then choose the **Access Article** link.

If the Access Article link doesn't work, another option is to choose the **Browse Journal** link and browse to the issue with your article.

② When the **Resource** is **UP Library** it means the library has some issues of this journal in its print collection on the lower level of the building. Select the **Browse Journal** link to see which years are available and make sure your article's year is included.
