- ❖ You will need to enter your UP network username and password (same as for email, PilotsUP, etc.). If you don't remember your network password, contact the Information Services Help Desk ([help@up.edu](mailto:help@up.edu)) or use the [Manage Password](#) web site.



- ❖ Plan ahead! Since you're away from campus, communication and delivery of materials takes a little bit longer. Give us plenty of time to get you what you need.
- ❖ Your best bets are online articles, articles you can request through [UP ILLiad](#), or materials available to you locally. The library can mail books to you, but you need to allow **1-2 weeks for shipping**, plus **you are responsible for the return postage**.
